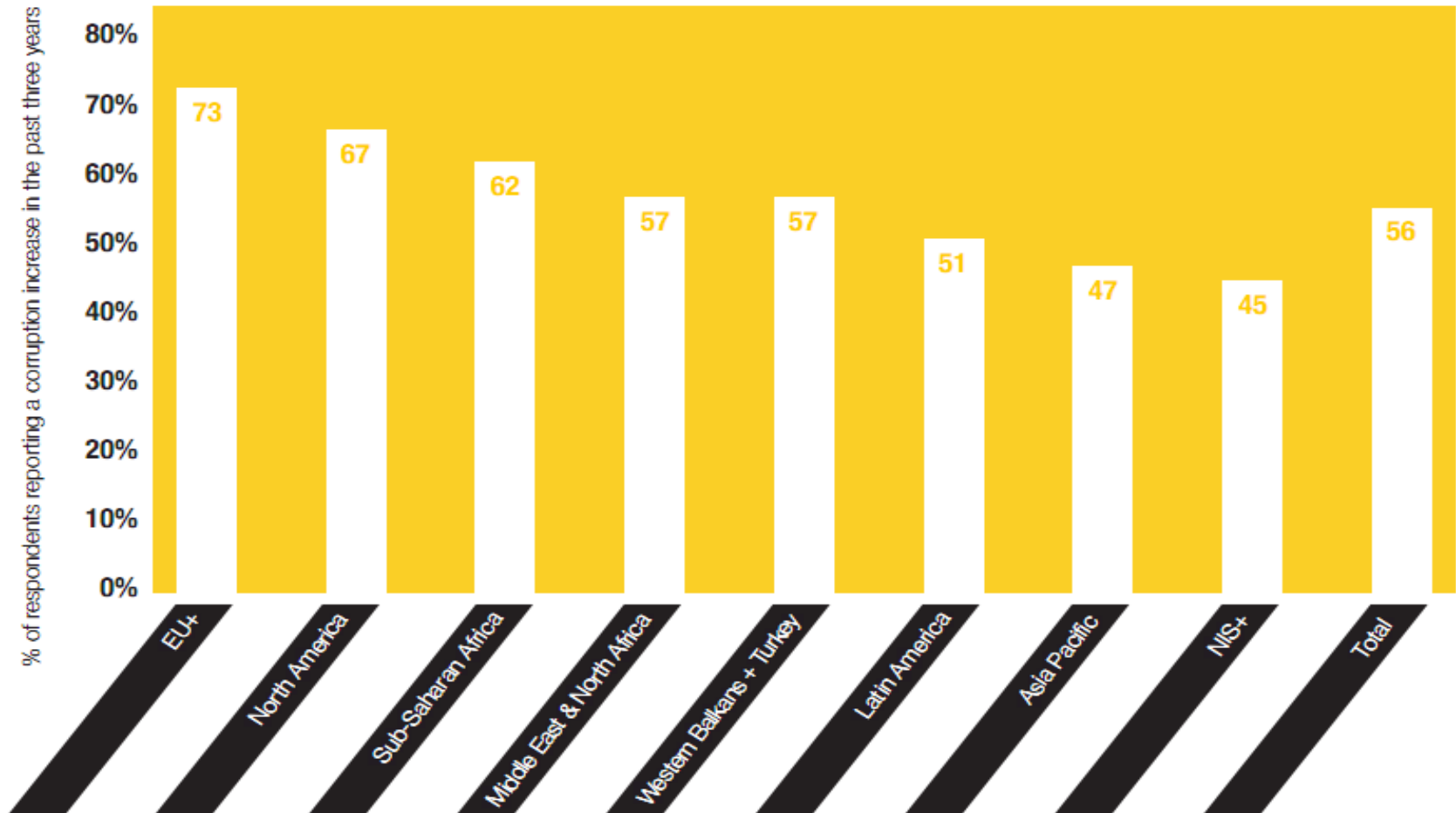

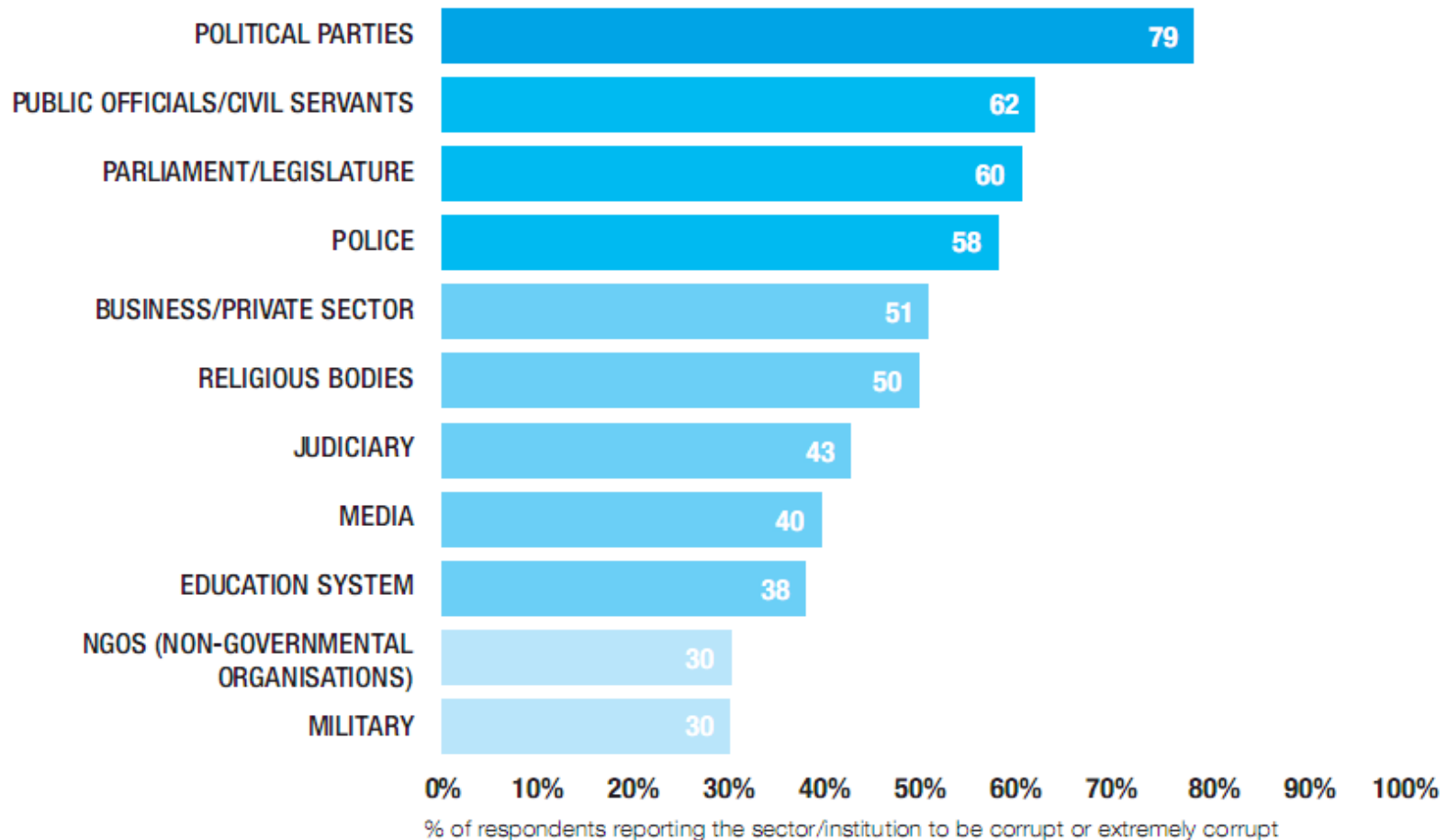
Basic informations

- Global survey by Transparent International
- Explores general public's opinion on and experiences with corruption (perception of corruption levels in institutions, government's effectiveness, bribery, personal engagement)
- Important indicator for authorities in fight against corruption

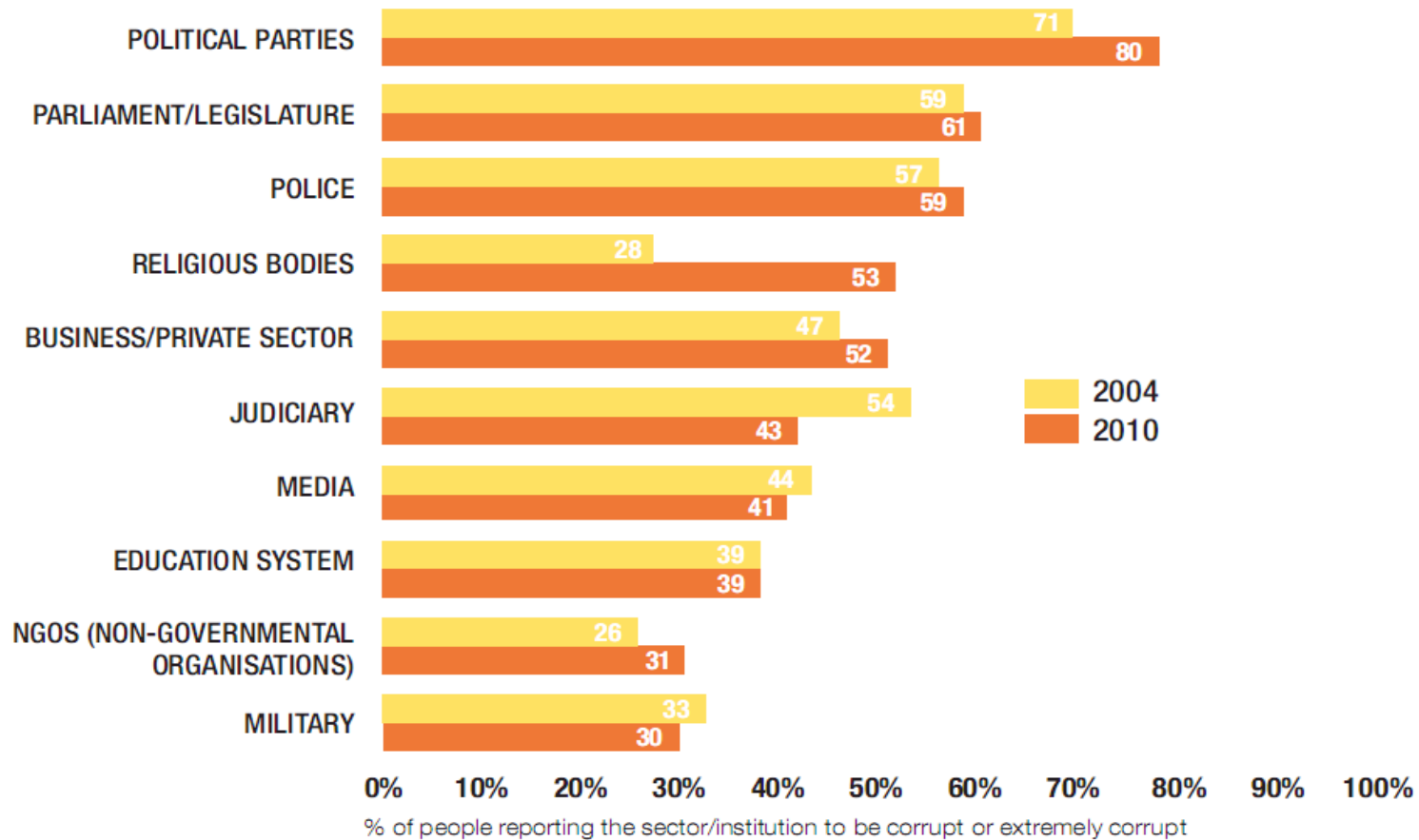
Changes in corruption levels in the past three years



Perceived levels of corruption in key institutions



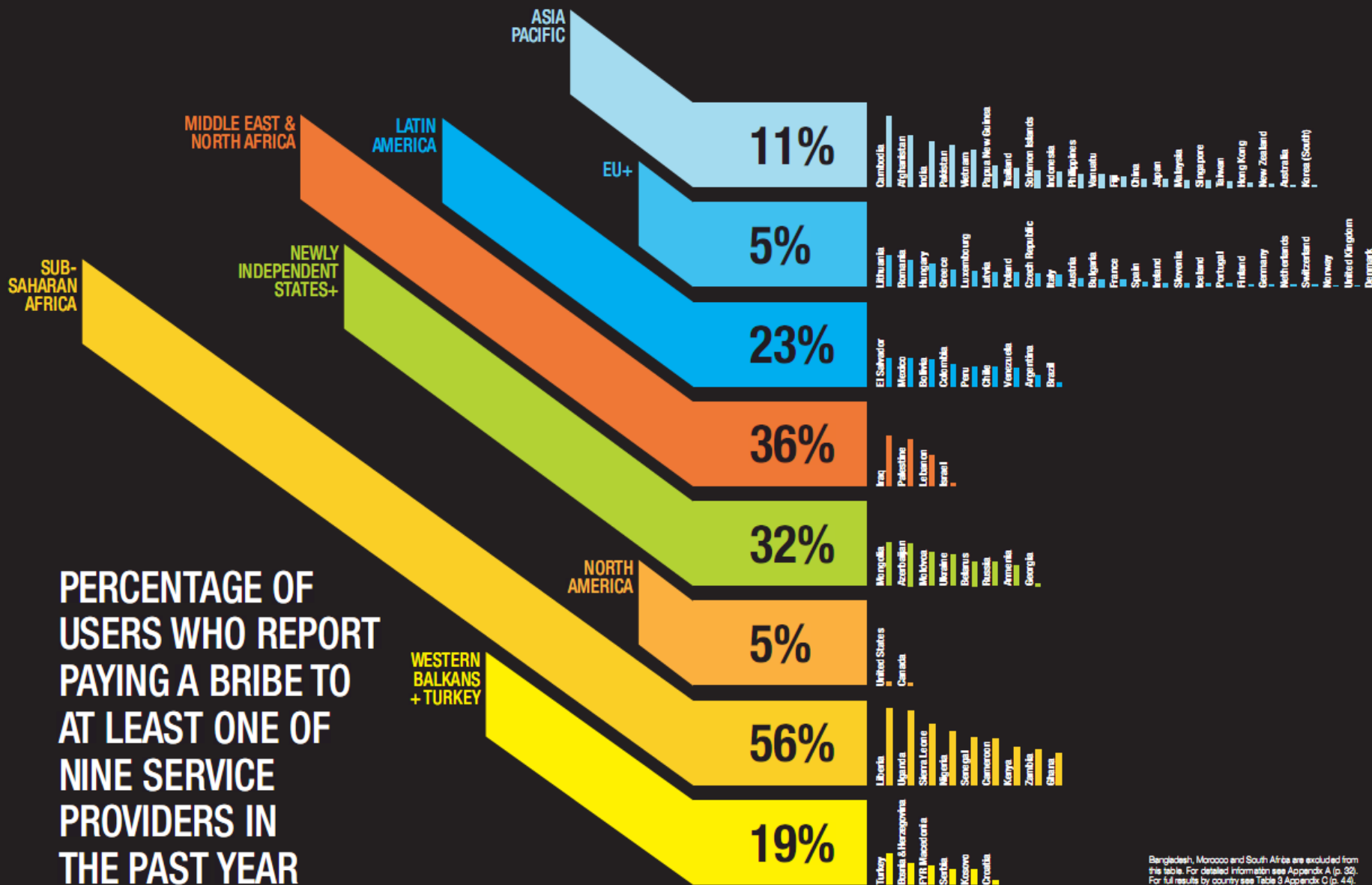
Corruption affecting key institutions/sectors, comparison over time



People's experiences with petty bribery

- **1 out of 4 worldwide has paid a bribe**
- Increased since 2009

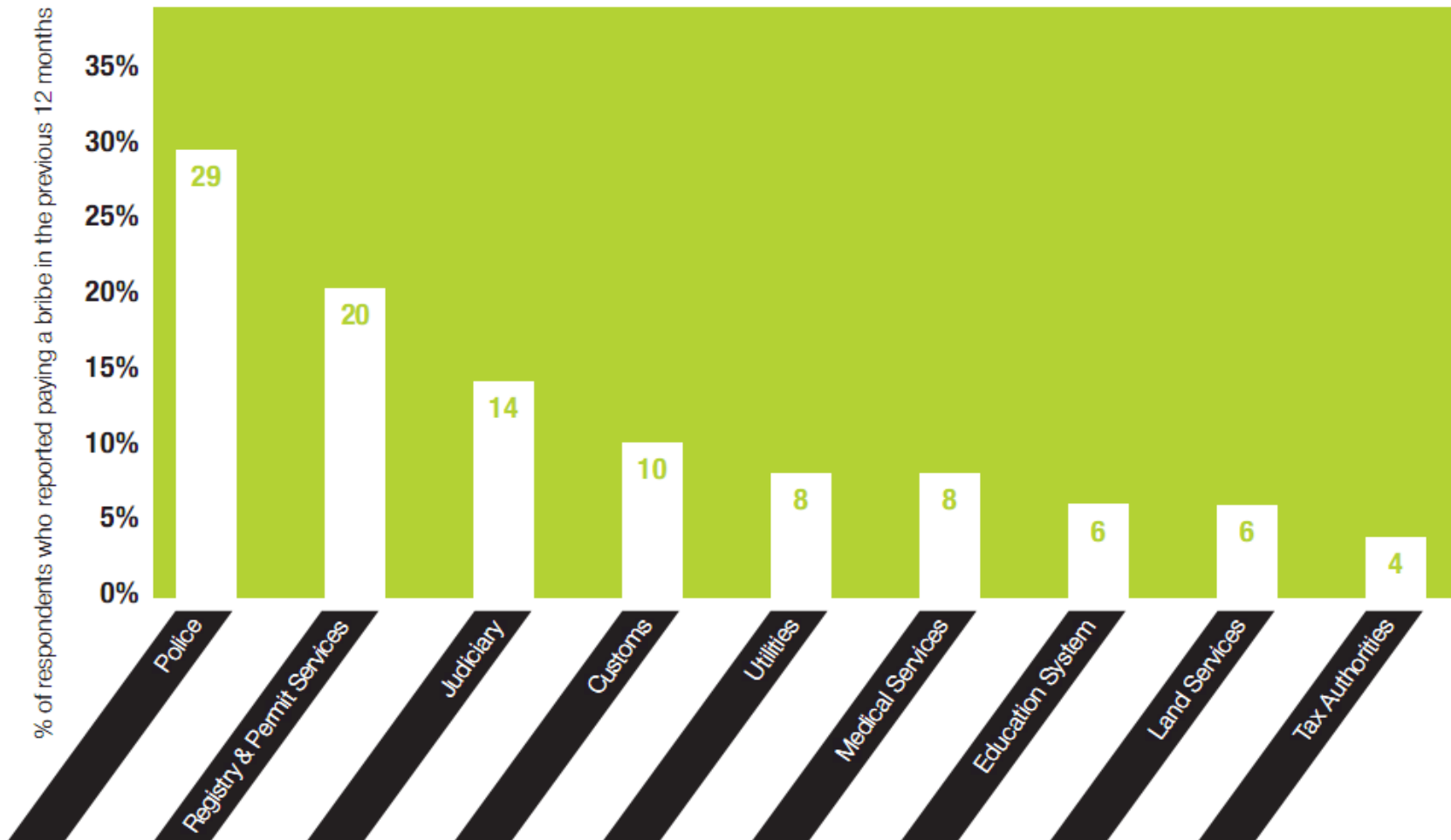

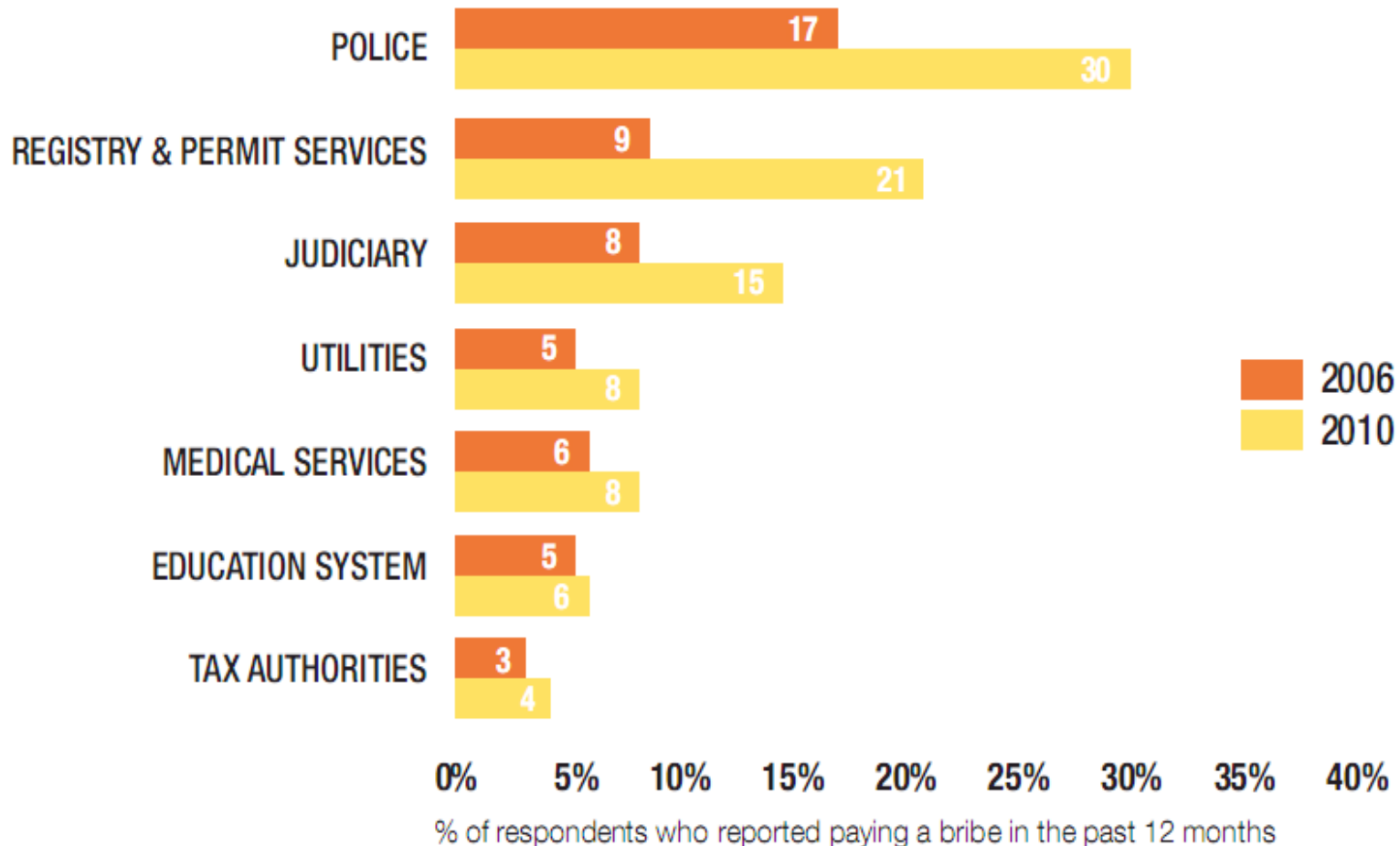
Why are bribes paid?

- to avoid a problem with the authorities (44%)
- to speed things up (22%)
- to receive a service entitled to (17%)

People's experiences with petty bribery, by service

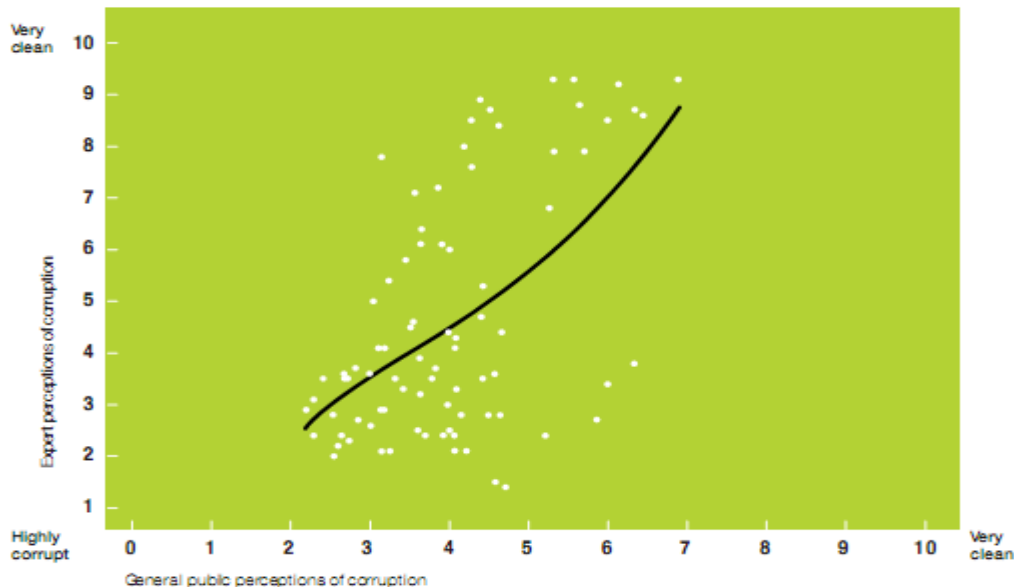


No reduction in petty bribery levels in the last five years

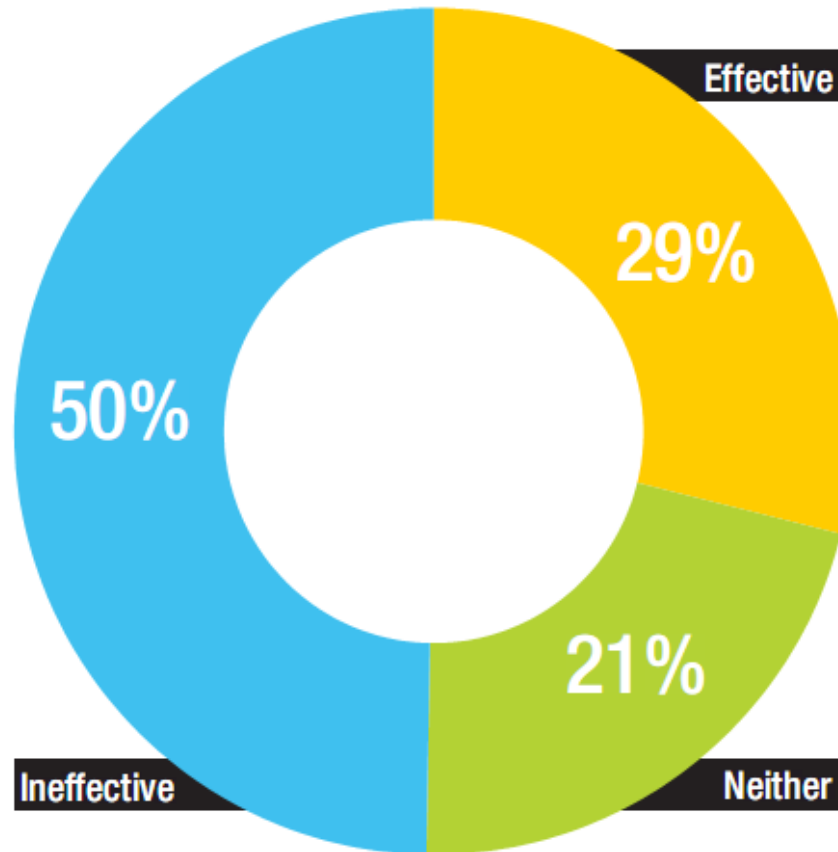


Corruption Perception Index

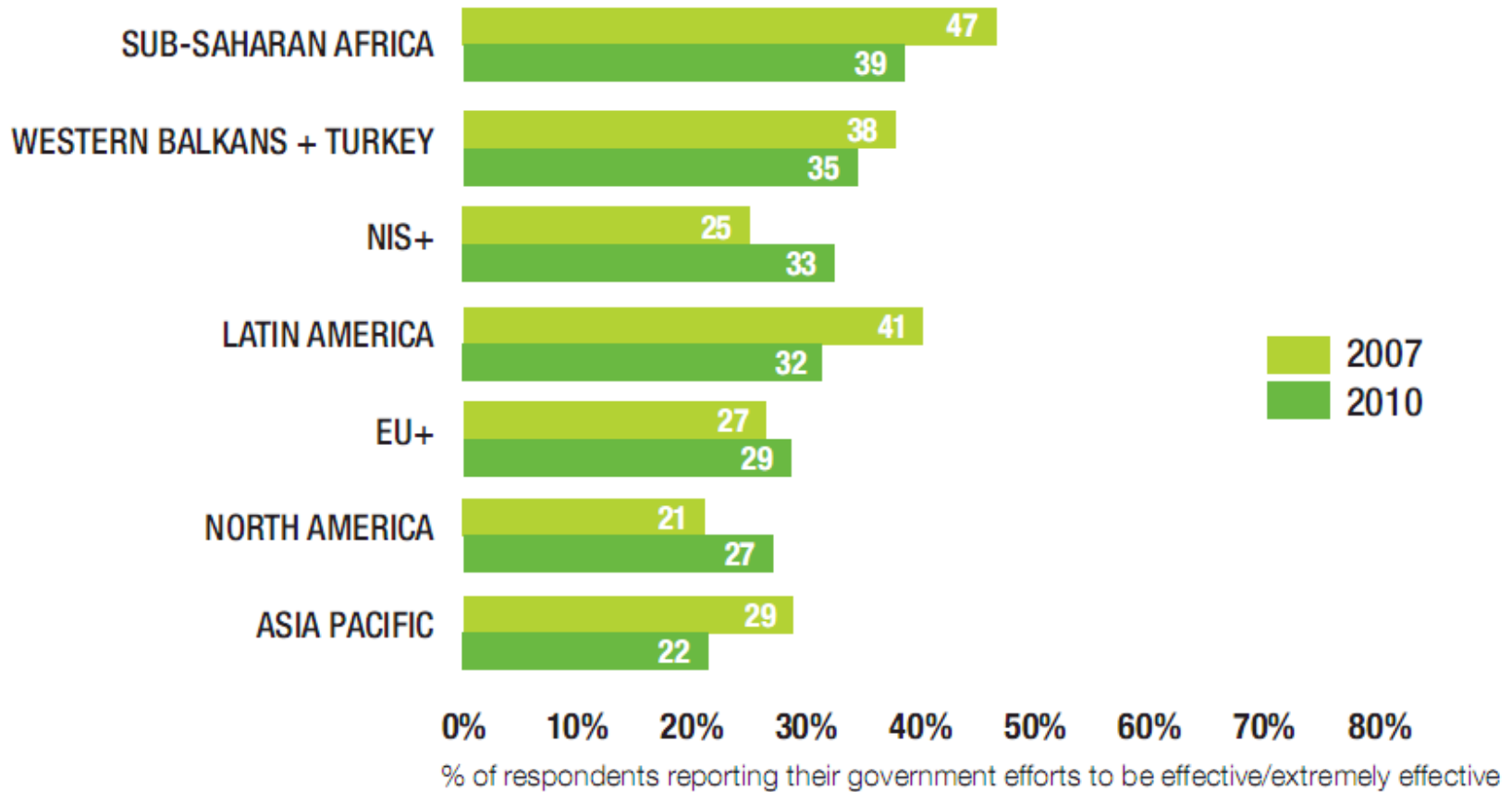
- Views of country analysts and business people

- General public opinion mostly align with experts' opinion



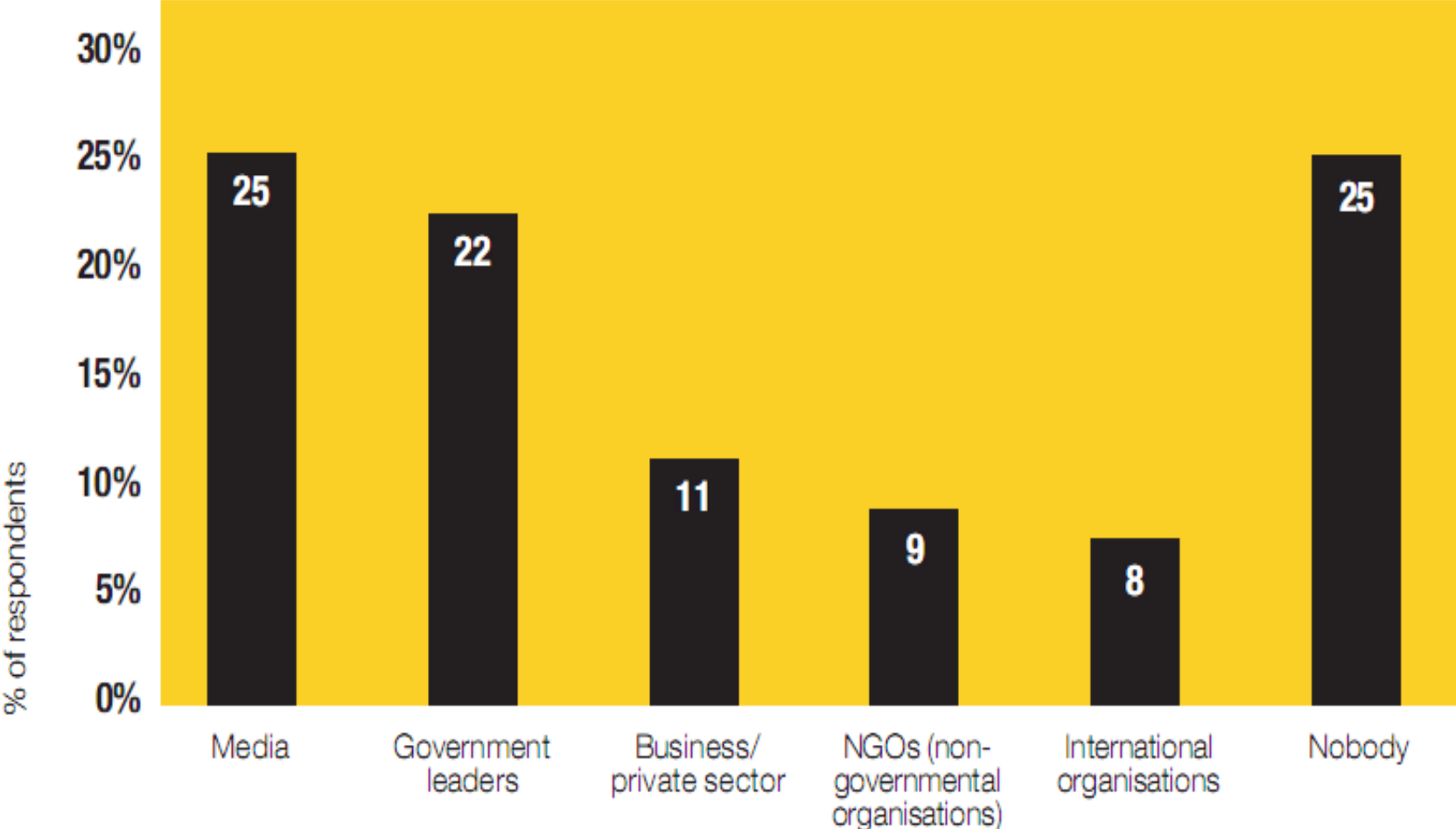
Government's efforts to fight corruption remain ineffective



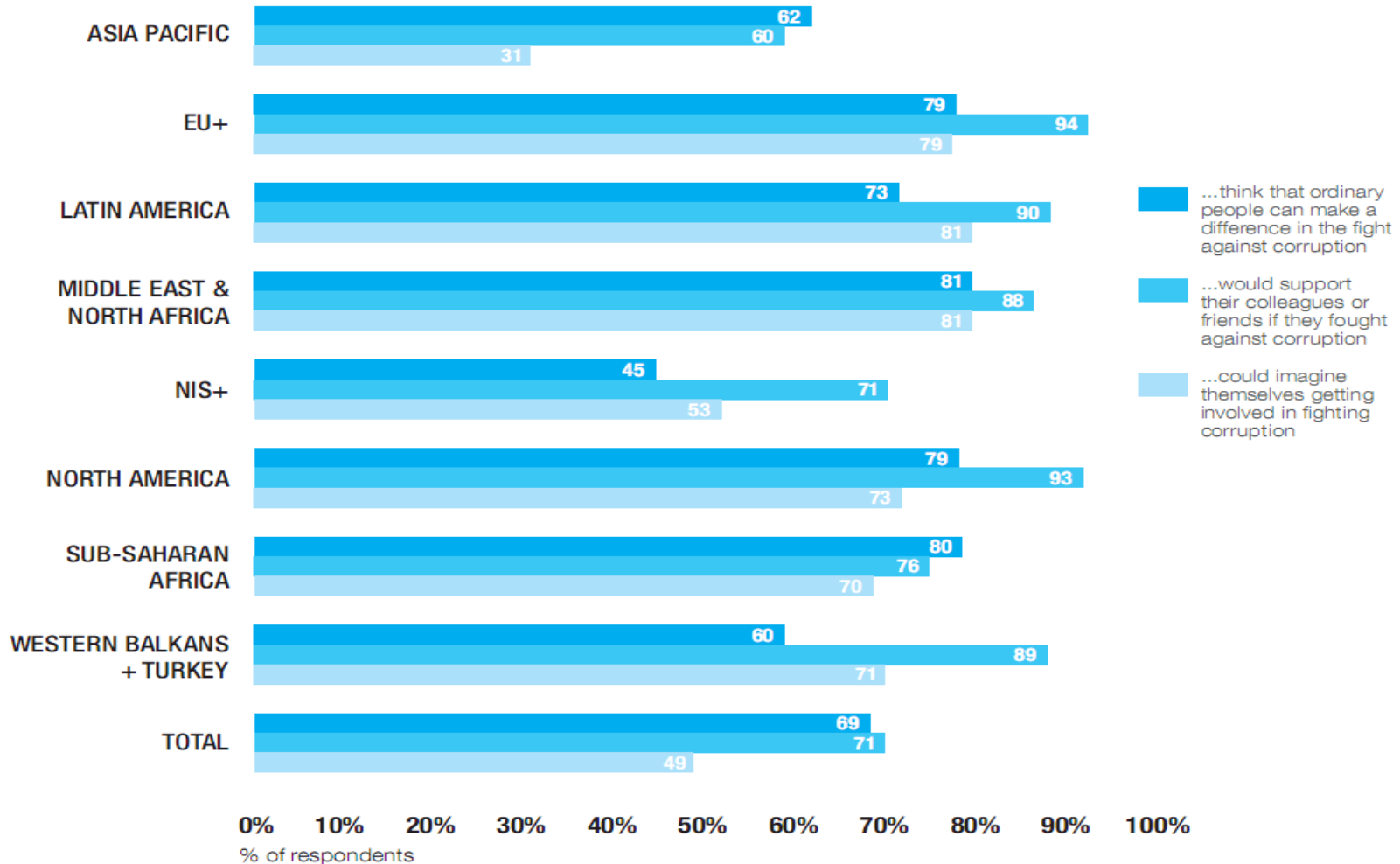
Government's effectiveness through regions



Whom do people trust the most to fight corruption in their country?

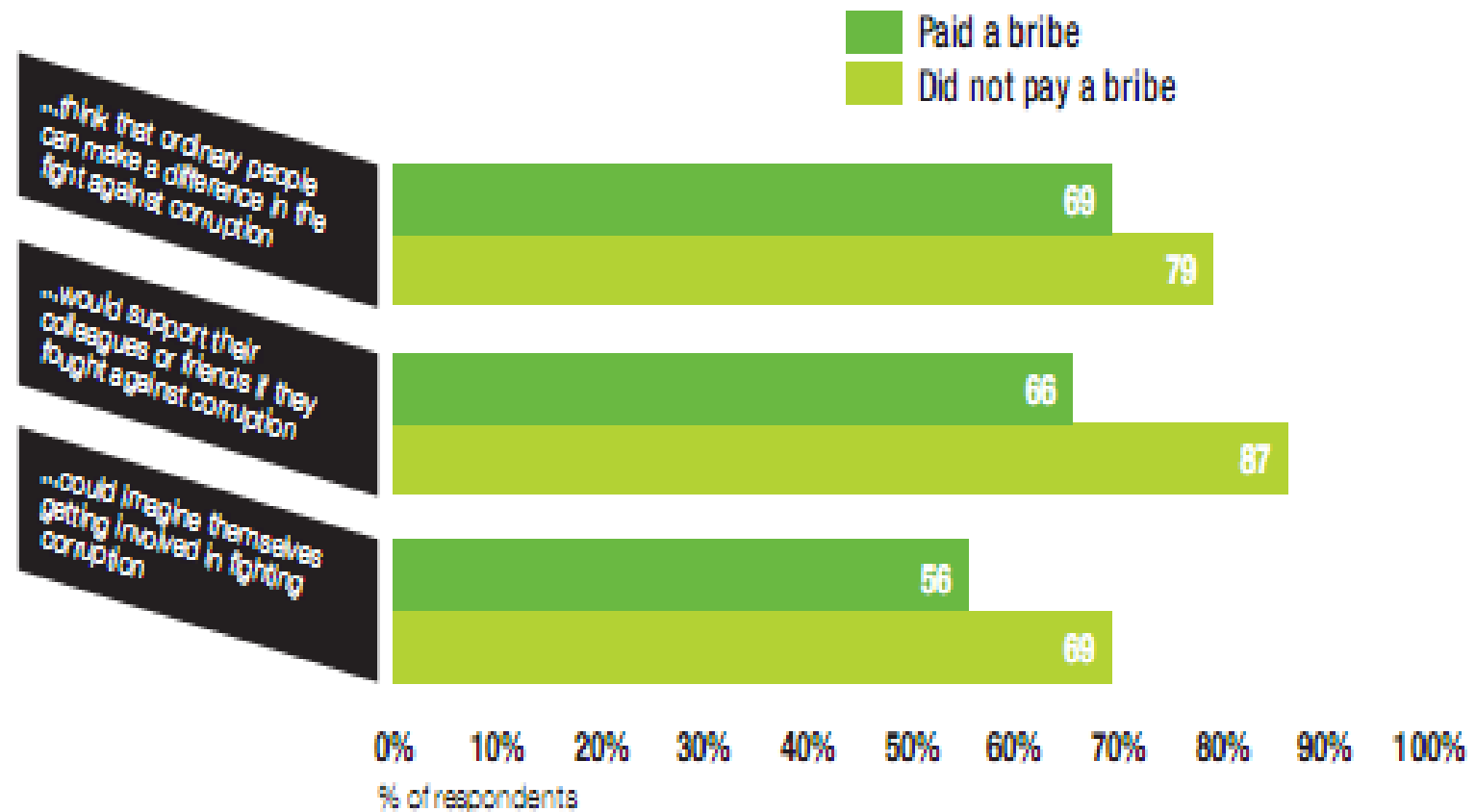


Are people willing to engage in the fight against corruption?
