



Internship offer at the Department of Sociology, Charles University in Prague

We offer a 2-month internship at the Department of Sociology, Faculty of Social Sciences, Charles University in Prague. The internship includes involvement in the project Beyond Security: The Role of Conflict in Resilience Building (CoRe).

Project theme: The project focuses on exploring the role of conflict in society in order to build resilience to current crises and future threats. Specifically, the internship should focus on and touch on areas that can be considered as causes or manifestations of the crises in society. This may include, e.g.:

- crisis of trust in institutions,
- social polarisation,
- populism,
- impacts of immigration,
- impacts of the international security situation,
- economic crises,
- building social resilience, etc.

Requirements: The internship can start at any time during the period 06/2025 to 06/2027 and is intended for researchers (including PhD students and post-docs) working outside the Czech Republic for at least two years in the last 5 years. Czech citizens are not excluded. The employment contract is for 0.5-1.0 at the applicant's choice.

Gross pay: 3200 EUR/month (varies according to family situation: with/without family).

Location of the workplace: Prague.
